

GENERAL GUIDE FOR SELECTING HEATER TYPES

For direct immersion into a liquid	Flanged Bushing Over the side Circulation Thunderbolts with mounting provisions Bottom outlet
For immersion applications not allowing direct contact with liquid	Strips (clamped to the outside) Tubulars (clamped to the outside) Tubular designed as a radiant heater Cast-in Pipe insert bushing heater
For air or other gases in a duct, oven, or pipe	Finned strips Finned tubulars Duct heaters Circulation Flow through process air heater
For solids	Bands Thunderbolt and standard cartridge Strips Tubulars Radiants
